As we reflect on the past year, we are proud to highlight the achievements and milestones that have brought our college closer to its vision. This annual report showcases the dedication, hard work and commitment to excellence that define our college community.

**IQAC Initiatives:** IQAC initiatives are pivotal in fostering a culture of excellence, driving our institution towards academic supremacy. It fostered collaboration between different institutions for quality assurance. It organised a **National Level Quiz Competition** on World Earth Day in collaboration with S D MahilaMahavidyalaya, Narwana in which 650 students from various states participated. In collaboration of BRA Janta College, Kaul & SNRL Jairam Girls College, LoharMajra our IQAC organised a **lecture** on “**Methodology in Focus: Enhancing Research Excellence**”. Resource person was Dr Anshul Bansal from SA Jain (PG) College Ambala City. It organised a **lecture on IPR** jointly with Dept of Economics & Commerce in Dr Hari Singh, HOD Mechanical EnggDept, NIT Kurukshetra was resource person. It arranged a **lecture on Cyber Crime** and the speakers were ShRavinder Nain ASI & Sh Vinod Kumar, Cyber Crime, Kaithal. It undertook **Tree Plantation Drive** in collaboration with NGO CARD, Bhopal. Board member CARD ShSudhirGullaiya lead the team to village SoluMajra to plant trees. In orientation programme of our college we arranged a lecture by Loveleena, Heartfulness

**Mou:** In this session we have signed **4 MoUs**. We have established partnership with an **NGO Centre for Advanced Research and Development (CARD), Bhopal**. In collaboration with CARD we have planted saplings in Primary School and Temple in village SoluMajra on 27-04-2024. We have MoU with **SD MahilaMahavidyalaya, Narwana** and **BAR Janta College, Kaul**. For improving mental health of stake holders, we have signed an MoU with **Heartfulness Education Trust, Vijaywada**.

**National Seminar:** Sanskrit Department of our college conducted a **National Seminar in collaboration with Haryana Sahitya Sanskrit Academy** on 21-10-2023 in which 72 teachers from various states of the country presented their research papers and 55 students from our college attended this seminar. 07 faculty members namely Dr Vineeta, Dr Poonam,



Ms Varkha, Dr Kamlesh, Dr Manju, Ms Sonia & Ms Bharti from our college presented research papers in this seminar.

**Research Work:**Our faculty members have made significant contributions to their fields by publishing research papers in journals and edited books. Dr Poonam, Assistant Professor, Department of English has published an edited book *Indian Literature as a Reflection of Society: Exploring Life, Culture, Ethics and Economic Realities*. Our five faculty members namely Dr Vineeta, Ms Bhawna, Dr Kamlesh, Dr Manju & Ms Sonia have published research papers in this edited book. Dr Vineeta, Professor, Department of English has published a research paper in UGC Care Group journal (July- Sep 2023) on the topic "*Hardy's Poetic Reminiscences oh His Wife Emma*" and two research papers in edited books. Ms Bhawna Department of Commerce, published research papers in Multidisciplinary International Journal of Information Movement and a research paper in edited book. Dr Nishi, Dept of Commerce, has published a Research paper in an edited book on the topic "*E-Learning Revolution: Transforming Education in the Digital Age*". "Dr Manju has published two research papers entitled Preserving "Our Rich Cultural Heritage" and "Vartman Yugmei Manav, Parivar, Samajevam Vishvake lie Vasudhaiv Kutumbakam ki Avdharna Mahatva" in edited books. Dr Kamlesh has published 1 research papers in research journal—in Gyan Garima Sindhu Vaigyanik Tatha Takniki Shabdawali on the topic "Srimadbhagwadgita Mei Nihit Shanti Shikshaek Udaharan" and 1 chapter in edited book.

Dr Vineeta & Dr Nishi attended a workshop on "Awareness against Sexual Harassment in HEIs" at KUK on 07/03/2024. Dr Kamlesh has attended 4 webinars/seminars and also presented papers. These were organised by DAV PG Girls College, Yamuna Nagar, KUK, Arya Girls College Ambala Cant, Govt College Makdona Ujjain. She has attended 4 FDPs, refresher and orientation.

**Certificate Courses:**Six departments from our college introduced and completed 30 hours add-on-certificates. In these certificate course 131 were enrolled and 127 completed these




