The policy of the college with regard to maintenance of the campus infrastructure is to upgrade and modernise the college. College has well established procedures to guide the different stakeholders involved in the maintenance and upgradation of the campus. Different committees have been formed to make the judicious decisions after discussion and deliberation in the interest of the college and students. The college has a purchase committee, construction committee, campus maintain committee and library committee formed by the Principal to systematically maintain and utilize the infrastructure. Purchase committee ensures and procures all the requirement as per the procedure laid down in accordance with Govt. code of purchases i.e. inviting quotations and placing the order in a very transparent manner. A library committee consisting of senior faculty members looks after the purchase of books. To make the library user friendly it has been partially computerised, books have been bar coded and security cameras have been installed. Construction committee takes care of decisions with regard to renovations or additions in the building. Committee refers the requirements to the Governing body and gets the approval of the same. Campus maintenance committee consisting of faculty members and non-teaching support staff looks after the up keep of buildings, water tanks, water filter and college lawns etc. Laboratories are periodically upgraded. The canteen committee ensures healthy, clean and reasonable priced eatables for students. Watch and ward staff and gardener look after the security and maintenance of lawns. First aid and common medicine are provided to the students free of costs. Common room facility is there for the students to relax. A hall with ICT facility is available to organise various activities. CCTV cameras are installed in the campus to safeguard the interest of the students. Two generators and seven inverters are installed for un-interrupted power supply. ROs equipped watercoolers are serviced regularly. College is periodically sanitized keeping in view Corona protocol. Academic infrastructure available in the college is optimally utilised through time -table. In the beginning of the semester time-table committee is framed. Committee takes into consideration the requirements according to workload submitted by HODs. Timetable is prepared so that optimum utilization of the infrastructure is ensured. The Governing body of the college and Principal regularly review the procedure followed by different committees of the college to ensure these to be effective and efficient.
